FAQs

- **I was unable to take a sample properly (e.g. I got urine on my stools) - what should I do?**
Call Laboratoires Réunis on [+352 780 290-1](tel:+3527802901). They will give you a suitable advice.
- **Do I have to pay for this screening test?**
NO, this screening test is for free.
- **Can I drop off the blue envelope containing my sample at a different laboratory?**
NO, you must either post your sample in a letter box or drop it off at a Laboratoires Réunis blood test centre of your choice.
- **Who will receive my result?**
It will be sent to you, the doctor you named on your identification sheet and the Centre de coordination des programmes de dépistage des cancers*. The result will be sent within 15 days.
- **I have sent my test but forgot to add the identification sheet. What should I do?**
Please contact as soon as possible the headquarter of the Laboratoires Réunis on [+352 780 290-1](tel:+3527802901). If necessary you will get a new test.



HOW TO DO THE TEST?



- **Take the identification sheet** showing personal information out of pocket ① and fill it in.



- **Remove the large white label** from your invitation letter and stick it on the identification sheet.



- **Remove the tube** from pocket ③.
- **Remove the small blue label** from your invitation letter and stick it to the flat side of the tube where it is marked "Nom, Date".



- **Make sure** that only the extreme end of the stem is covered in stool matter.
- **Insert the stem** into the tube and screw the cap back on.



- **Ensure that the tube is properly closed and shake it** vigorously to mix the liquid with the stool matter.



- **Wrap the green absorbent paper around the tube and place it in the plastic protection box.**
- **Check that you have correctly attached the blue label** to the tube and close the protection box firmly.



- **Urinate just prior** to starting your test.
- **Remove the stool collection paper** from pocket ③ and attach it to the toilet seat using the stickers. Press lightly on the paper to make a slight hollow.
- **Sit on the toilet** and deposit your stools.



- **Unscrew the tube** to open it. **Remove the cap** with the green stem.



- **Scrape the surface of the stools** in several places using the stem so that the ribbed end is covered with stool matter.



- **Insert the plastic protection box containing your tube into the clear plastic "Safety Bag"** which can be found in pocket ②; seal the bag hermetically.



- **Insert the completed identification sheet and the "Safety Bag"** containing your sample into the blue prepaid envelope showing the Laboratoires Réunis address which can be found in pocket ②. Seal the blue envelope hermetically.



- **Mail your blue envelope the same day.** If it's not possible to send it the same day or if it's just prior to a weekend or a bank holiday, keep the envelope for a **maximum of 3 days** in your fridge.
